

MAKE IT IN TWO PARTS



A sectional bedspread, made in two pieces and tied together. When ready for the laundry just take it apart and you have two easy-to-handle pieces for the wash tub and ironing board.

A SMART bedspread to help eliminate your laundry problem is made in two pieces, just tied together—easier to handle, easier to launder! If the material is 36" wide and used horizontally, three widths are required: two for the spread, the third to go around the pillow, as shown, and be fastened with four large snaps to the upper section of the spread. The loops of the bow (see detail above) are gathered inside, sewed flat to the lower edge of the upper section and in corresponding positions, close to upper edge of the lower section. The ends of the bow are left free to tie, to join the sections. Tape may be used for binding edges and for bows.

For a frilly room a charming spread is made in a dainty print, or smart checks, trimmed with ruffles, the sections joined by fluffy bows. On an initialed cover—pretty eyelet embroidery beading with ribbon run through. Try a denim spread in a boy's room and trim it with tailored braid.
